- Rewrote and updated the 30 year old town Wetland code to afford the town better environmental and legal protection
- Received Amherst Davis Memorial Farmer Citizen Award, 2009

- Worked on and supported a town wide drainage code, which reduced road runoff and met the town's MS4 requirements
- Worked on and supported Big Box Store Legislation which limited size of stores in Southold and protected small business owners
- Worked with town board members to limit and then decrease the size of government
